Diatomite has been used as a filter aid for nearly a century.

The ore is a soft, friable siliceous mineral composed of the skeletons of microscopic plants deposited on the bottoms of oceans and lakes after the Miocene Age.

Diatomaceous earth is an amorphous form of silica with varying particle shape and has the ability to form highly permeable, but rigid and incompressible fiber cakes, which translates into efficient and economical filtrations.
